Doria Lynch is the special projects manager at the U.S. District Court for the Southern District of Indiana, where she manages the court's outreach programs, among other duties. She is a 2003 graduate of Kalamazoo College and received her Master of Arts in Public History from Indiana University in 2007. She was a contributing author to a forthcoming collection of biographies of Indiana's Court of Appeals judges, and she also authored biographies for Indiana's 200: The People Who Shaped the Hoosier State (2016) and Justices of the Indiana Supreme Court (2010). Doria recently managed the production of a documentary film, *And Justice for All: Indiana's Federal Courts*, which was nominated for two 2018 Emmy Awards in the Lower Great Lakes Region. She received the Dorothy Riker Hoosier Historian Award from the Indiana Historical Society for her contributions to the field of historical scholarship in 2015.
