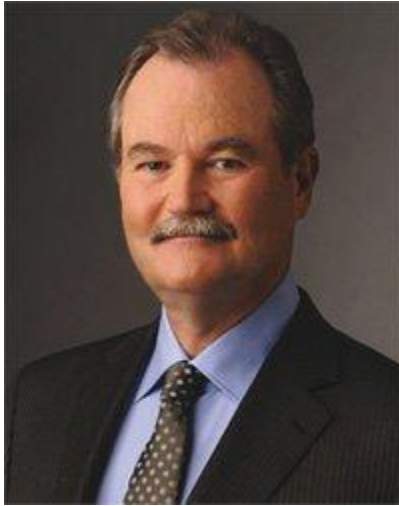


## 2011 Distinguished Leader Award Recipient
