

CD(SA) ASSESSMENT CALENDAR 2019

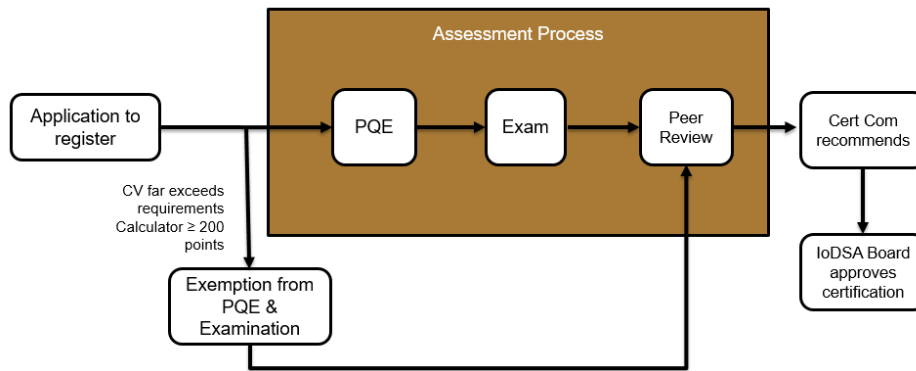
The CD(SA) is a professional designation offered by the IoDSA to recognize mastery in directorship. The aim of the 3 part assessment is to determine whether the individual is competent against each of the 20 competencies included in the Director Competency Framework.



Details of this process are presented in the CD(SA) Handbook.

The process is presented in the figure below.

Terms & Conditions for Exemption:

- Director Certification nominates and completes recommendation on completion of process
- Certification Committee makes recommendation and IoDSA Board Approves

In 2019, there will be three intakes for CD(SA).

Please note:

- Application for registration cannot be completed without proof of payment. You will therefore need to request an invoice for the CD(SA) Phase 1: Registration from our certifications department at certifications@iodsa.co.za
- Invoices for the Assessment Fee are only raised once the Portfolio of Qualifications and Experience (PQE) has been received
- Candidates cannot apply for exemption. Once the application for registration has been received by Director Certification, then a candidate whose experience far exceeds the minimum requirement could be nominated for exemption. Exemption is awarded at the discretion of the IoDSA Certification Committee.
- Payment needs to be received for the assessments before the results will be released or communicated to the candidate.
