Each *team* is required to provide a judge for each round of regional competition in which it competes. For example, a single team must cover 2 trial rounds. Two teams must fill 4 rounds of competition, etc. The judge requirement may be filled by a single person judging multiple rounds, or by any number of people serving enough rounds to satisfy the overall team obligation. Attorneys and Attorney-coaches are eligible to serve on a judging panel. For each name you submit, complete a separate judge form (make additional copies as needed).
