

Sponsorship and Trade Show participation will be confirmed only after the completed application and 25% deposit is received.

The Conference Host reserves the right, at their total discretion, to decline any application; in this instance, the deposit will be refunded.

Sponsorship availability is on a first-come, firstserved basis.

Trade Show space will also be assigned on a first-come first-served basis, and will take into consideration the level of sponsorship.

NOTE: If additional square footage is required, this will be based on level of sponsorship AND availability. The additional cost of \$15.00 USD per square foot is to be paid by the vendor.

The deadline for submitting your sponsorship and trade show application is December 31, 2019. The Trade Show floor plan will be designed based on the approved applications received by this date. Booth allocations and floor plan layout are at the sole discretion of the Conference Host.





Zeidler Dome Theatre [non-tilted dome] [Planetarium]

TELUS World of Science – Edmonton 11211 142 Street

The new Zeidler Dome at TELUS World of Science – Edmonton has a large cove area for the setup of additional equipment if required for the IPS 2020 conference for the sponsor demonstrations. The following information should allow sponsors the capability to see how their specific equipment for the dome presentations can be integrated into the space.

Current System Configuration

Entrance to Zeidler Dome



Dome Specifications

Astro-Tec Ulteria Dome, 23 meters in diameter, flat dome (non-tilted). Re-panelled in 2018 with theatre renovation.

Seating

Concentric seating with Skeie, Sonate Recliner (with 45° pitch angle).

Sound System

Definiti 17.2 sound system (17 JBL SRX835P 3-Way bass reflex self-powered speakers, 2 JBL SRX828SP duel 18" self-powered subwoofer system)
Wireless microphones + 6 additional XLR inputs and RCA and 1/8 inputs as well.

Projection System Installed in Facility

Sky-Skan Inc., 10K projection system utilizing 12 Sony 4K, VPL-GTZ280 projectors, with capture system to output HDMI inputs from computer or other sources to the dome.

Capture system inputs found at both the operator console and at the central stage (HDMI), up to 4K input.

Central Stage

Central stage has a 189" (or 15.75' or 4.8 metre) diameter carpeted stage (one step up to stage).



Four locations with power (120 V AC), total of 7 outlets. North American outlets.





AV inputs (HDMI, RCA, 1/8", XLR inputs) for capture system



Cove Space

9' [2.7 m] width walkway in cove area. Some areas have stairs which limits the space in those areas but there is plenty of free cove space for additional projection systems to be installed.





Four 220 V 3-phase outlets




Numerous vacant 120 V 15A outlets around perimeter of cove area.



Space between dome spring-line and lighting valence is about 7" [17.78 cm]. This allows enough space for projector image output on the dome.

Projector configuration in the cove



We **do not** have an exhaust system for projectors with high heat output in the theatre. Projectors with that output will just output into the cove space if used.

Width of area around Theatre's central stage: Approximately 36"W [91.44 cm W]

Doors into computer room from Theatre: $29\text{"W} \times 79\text{"H}$ [73.66 cm W x 200.66 cm H] Need to do a 90 degree turn from the theatre door to the computer room door.

Access to Console Operator: [One large step up] Approximately 29"W [73.66 cm W]

Access from Console Operator to Cove Area: $28\text{"W} \times 42\text{"H}$ dome to floor clearance [71.12 cm W x 106.68 cm H]







Electricity

In Canada the power plugs and sockets are type A and B. The standard voltage is 120 V and the standard frequency is 60 Hz.



Type A: This socket has no alternative plugs



Type B: This socket also works with plug A

You can use your electric appliances in Canada, if the standard voltage in your country is in between 110 - 127 V (as is in the US, Canada and most South American countries). Manufacturers take small deviations (plus or minus 5%) into account. Be careful if you bring appliances from Japan (100 V).

IMPORTANT: If the standard voltage in your country is in the range of 220 - 240 V (as is in the UK, Europe, Asia, Africa and Australia), please ensure you bring the required voltage converter for Canada.

The Canadian Electrical Code requires that electrical equipment and power cords be approved for use in Canada.

Smoking - Edmonton Convention Centre

In compliance with the City of Edmonton Bylaw 14614, our conference venues do not permit the use of cannabis, tobacco, vaping and e-cigarette products within 10 metres (33 feet) of doorways, windows, and air intakes. This also includes patios.

Smoking - TELUS World of Science

Use of cannabis, tobacco, vaping and e-cigarette will not be allowed on or within the science centre. It will also not be allowed in the adjacent Coronation Park. Designated smoking areas will be clearly marked.

Cancellation Policy

In exceptional circumstances, the Conference Host will consider the cancellation of their Contract with Sponsors and Vendors, but only if the following conditions are met:

- The Sponsor or Vendor must submit a written and signed request for cancellation by March 16, 2020 [3 months out].
- The Sponsor or Vendor must give reasons for their cancellation request; the Conference Host has the right to accept or decline the reasons for the cancellation request.


