Renewal applications for licensure of Illinois Physical Therapist Assistants have been mailed out. Last year Illinois PTs experienced delays in receiving their new licenses. These delays were due to state budget cuts which decreased the size of staff at the Department of Professional Regulations.

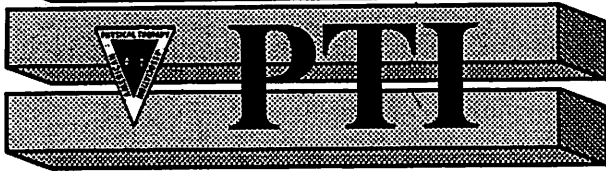
The following procedure is recommended:

- 1) Make a copy of your completed application and check prior to mailing to the Department.
- 2) At minimum, note the date you mailed your application (your best proof is to send it certified mail, return receipt requested).
- 3) Mail your application and check A.S.A.P. Delays in mailing could result in you not receiving your new license before your old one expires.

Using this system will provide a tracking mechanism should your license not arrive on time.
