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### Overview

The award recognizes effective leadership and outstanding accomplishments and contributions within the IRP community.

### Award Criteria

- Current or past IRP member; jurisdiction or industry
- Outstanding contributor to the IRP community
- Leader in the jurisdictions and the IRP community
- Known for developing creative and proactive programs within his/her jurisdiction or for company

### Nomination Guidelines

- Nominations may be made at any time during the 12 months prior to the established deadline.
- Nominations must be received prior to the deadline to be considered for the award.

- Members of the Awards Nominating Committee are not eligible to win.
- Nominations will be emailed to [irpmail@irpinc.org](mailto:irpmail@irpinc.org) using the nomination form. The IRP, Inc. staff will compile and present the award nominations to the Awards Nominating Committee.

### Awards Presentation

The winner is recognized with a plaque. If the award winner attends the IRP Annual Meeting, he/she will be presented with the award at that event.



### Examples of Qualifying Criteria

- Nominee has served as a jurisdictional member or industry advisor on the IRP Board of Directors, standing committees, subcommittees, or task forces.
- Nominee has taken key leadership roles within the IRP community.
- Nominee has developed new programs benefiting the IRP community.
- Nominee has demonstrated ongoing commitment to fairness in the administration of the IRP.
- Nominee has demonstrated willingness to act as a mentor for new membership.
- Nominee engages other members of the IRP community in key efforts.
- Nominee has actively participated in support of the concepts embodied by IRP.
