

# CT - IRP INTERSTATE BUS FEE SCHEDULE

Class Code: 02

Expiration month: April– Prorated Nov. 1

The formula for computing fees for Interstate buses in Connecticut IRP is as follows:

FEE: (by gross weight) X \$1.25 per hundred pounds + \$39.00

Gross weight is determined by multiplying seating capacity times 150, then add this sum to the light weight.

Fee per bus X number of buses being registered X fee factor.

(Fee factor computed by dividing number of miles traveled in all jurisdictions into number of miles traveled in Connecticut)

## EXAMPLE:

Company travels 950,000 total miles and CT mileage is 50,000. Number of buses being registered is 20. Light weight of each bus is 18000 LBS. carrying capacity is 46 passengers.

**1<sup>ST</sup> STEP:** Multiply 46 X 150 = 6900 lbs.  
 Add to light weight 18000  
 Gross weight of bus=24900 lbs.

**2<sup>ND</sup> STEP:** Multiply by fee                    249  
 \$1.25 per hundred    X 1.25  
 pounds    \$311.25  
     + 39.00  
 Per Bus =                                        \$350.25

**3<sup>RD</sup> STEP:** Multiply fee per            \$350.25  
 bus X number                                       x 20  
 of buses                                        \$7005.00

**4<sup>TH</sup> STEP:** Compute fee factor. Divide 950000 by 50000.00000(carry to 5<sup>th</sup> position).  
 Equals .05263 for the fee factor.

**5<sup>TH</sup> STEP:** Multiply total amount (step 3) times fee factor (step 4). Equals \$368.68 for total amount due.

If a bus is carrying standees the charge is \$2.00 additional per bus.
