RE: 2019 Indiana Registration and Commercial Vehicle Excise Tax (CVET) Fees Updates

During the 2018 legislative session, the Indiana General Assembly passed House Enrolled Act HEA 1290, which updated and clarified registration-related fees, effective July 1, 2018 (unless otherwise noted below).

Transportation Infrastructure Improvement Fee (TIIF):

- TIIF is apportioned if the vehicle subject to the fee is registered under IRP. (*Note:* Effective upon passage – March 21, 2018)

Commercial Vehicle Excise Tax (CVET):

- CVET is calculated Oct. 1 of each year and is effective until Jan.1 of the following year.
- The annual calculation for CVET for commercial vehicles other than semitrailers excludes the supplement fees to register hybrid and electric vehicles.
- The sum of registration fees paid do not include the TIIF and supplement fees for registering hybrid vehicles and electric vehicles during the state's fiscal year (July 1 – June 30).
- The updated 2019 Indiana CVET schedule is attached.

Not-For-Hire Bus and Recovery Vehicle Registration Fees:

- Fees are distributed in accordance with Indiana Code section 9-18.1-5-10.5.

REMINDER: Please submit each of the fees below separately to the IRP Clearinghouse:

- Standard Registration fees;
- TII fee;
- CVET fees; and
- Hybrid and Electric supplemental registration fees.
