Subject: Changes in Rhode Island IRP Registration Fees

To IRP, Inc. and All IRP Member Jurisdictions:

This letter notifies IRP jurisdictions of a recent legislative change to certain registration fees. The State of Rhode Island is lowering registration fees for most vehicles over 10,000 pounds.

As per Rhode Island General Law (RIGL) Title 31, Section 31-6-1.1, fees for trucks and tractors will use a new schedule. Buses are still subject to the RIGL Section 31-6-1 fee schedule (which is unchanged).
