Subject: **Extension Notice for Maryland Apportioned Vehicle Registrations**

To: **Whom it may concern:**

On March 12, 2020, Governor Larry Hogan signed the Executive Order – Extending Licenses, Permits, Registrations, and Other Governmental Authorizations, and Offering Suspension of Legal Time Requirements.

As a result of Maryland being under a state of emergency due to the coronavirus virus and its impacts on state government operations, Maryland requests that all International Registration Plan (IRP) jurisdictions and enforcement personnel refrain from taking enforcement action on vehicles bearing a Maryland-apportioned vehicle registration. The Executive Order will impact those individuals with an apportioned registration expiring on or after March 12, 2020. This extension is in effect until further notice.

Currently, the Maryland Motor Carrier Division remains open, although staffing levels may be diminished. We will continue processing all mailed in or electronically submitted renewal applications submitted as quickly as possible, but there may be some delay.
