Subject: Emergency IRP and IFTA permit waiver

To: All Law Enforcement Agencies:

Under the provisions granted in NRS 706.561, the Department is temporarily suspending Nevada IRP and IFTA trip and fuel permit requirements for those vehicles providing direct assistance with hurricane Irma relief efforts. A copy of this letter must be retained in each vehicle operating under this waiver. Upon request, operators of exempted vehicles will be required to produce identification sufficient to prove the vehicle or load transported is being used exclusively for relief efforts.

Direct assistance terminates when a driver or commercial motor vehicle is used in interstate commerce to transport cargo or provide services not directly supporting the emergency relief efforts. Motor Carriers or drivers currently subject to a State or Federal out-of-service order are not eligible for the relief granted by this declaration.

This waiver is limited to the fees associated with temporary registration and fuel permits in the State of Nevada only. This waiver does not imply or grant an exception to any Federal laws administered by the Federal Motor Carrier Safety Administration, U.S Department of Transportation, or other state laws regarding the reporting, registration, or operation of commercial motor vehicles.

This waiver shall remain in effect for the duration of the declared emergency or until 11:59 pm on October 8, 2017, whichever comes first.
