Re: Extension Notice for Alberta Apportioned Vehicle Registrations

Please distribute the following information to all International Registration Plan (IRP) member jurisdictions:

In response to the COVID-19 pandemic, Alberta has declared a state of emergency under the *Public Health Act*. As a result, the Registrar, Motor Vehicle Services with Alberta Transportation advises that under *Section 75.1 of the Operator Licensing and Vehicle Control Regulation, Alta Regulation 320/2002* a grace period is being provided for all trucks and buses expiring on or after March 23, 2020.

Alberta requests that all IRP jurisdictions and enforcement personnel refrain from taking enforcement action on vehicles bearing Alberta expired cab cards, Certificate of Registrations and apportioned plate decals on vehicles operating in your jurisdiction until May 15, 2020.

Currently, the Alberta Prorate Services unit remains operational, although staffing levels may be diminished. We will continue processing all electronically submitted renewal applications submitted as quickly as possible, but there may be some delay.
