- All Illinois Secretary of State offices and Driver Services facilities are CLOSED to the public through April 30, 2020.
- Expiration dates for driver's licenses, identification cards, vehicle registrations and other transactions and document filings will be extended at least 90 days after Driver Services Facilities reopen.
