Driver Services Facilities are Now Open

- From June 1 through July 31, facilities will focus on serving ONLY [new drivers](#), customers with expired driver's licenses/ID cards and vehicle transactions. [Press Release](#) [Facility Finder](#) [Renew your vehicle sticker](#) [Facilities Reopening PSA](#)
- All driver's licenses, ID cards, vehicle registration, restricted driving permits and monitoring device driving permits that are currently expired or set to expire by July 31 have been extended until Oct. 1, 2020.
- All employees are wearing face masks and customers are required to do the same. Plexiglass dividers have been installed at all work stations and tape has been applied to the floor in 6-foot intervals to follow social distancing guidelines, limiting the number of customers inside a facility at one time.

Brief synopsis in regards to IRP: We re-opened our offices on June 1, 2020. Illinois IRP plates expired on March 31, 2020; however, our registrants have been granted an extension until September 30, 2020 under the newest executive order.
