Subject: Extension of credentials for Kansas based IRP vehicles used in interstate commerce, per Executive Order 20-36.

Date: May 27, 2020

The Kansas Division of Vehicles, Commercial Motor Vehicle Division, does hereby extend the IRP registration for registered vehicles 60 days beyond the expiration of the State of Disaster Emergency that will be in effect until June 30, 2020.

Therefore, with the 60 day extension of registration, the vehicles will need to have current credentials in their possession at 12:01am September 1, 2020. We request law enforcement refrain from issuing citations as long as the motor carrier is operating within the guidelines of Kansas Executive Order 20-36. in association with disaster assistance.
