Subject: Notice of Extension Expiration for OH IRP Vehicle Registrations expiring on or after March 18, 2020.

After Governor DeWine declared a state of emergency due to the COVID-19 virus on March 9, 2020, the Ohio General Assembly passed House Bill 197. This bill, which was signed by Governor DeWine on March 27, 2020, extended all license and registration dates that expired during the state of emergency to 90 days after the emergency was over, or December 1<sup>st</sup>, whichever came soonest. This included all International Registration Plans (IRP) or IRP Temporary Authorization Authority (TA) that expired on or after March 18, 2020.

Since it is now September and the state of emergency is not yet over, the official expiration date for all licenses and registration extended under HB 197 will be **December 1, 2020**. In order to remain valid, all licenses and registrations that expired since March 18th must be renewed prior to December 1<sup>st</sup>, 2020. Please consider renewing soon in order to meet this deadline.
