Re: Expiration of 2nd Letter of Extension Notice for OH IRP Vehicle Registrations due to COVID-19 Pandemic

Please be advised that effective 7/1/2021, the registration expiration extension for OH IRP Vehicle Registrations as outlined in the Ohio Bureau of Motor Vehicles' 2nd Letter of Extension Notice for OH IRP Vehicle Registrations due to COVID-19 Pandemic, dated 12/2/2020, has expired in accordance with Ohio House Bill 404.

All vehicles bearing an Ohio IRP Apportioned Plate, or an Ohio Forty-Five Day Apportionment Authorization (TA), on or after 7/1/2021, must have an active registration. An active registration is one whose registration expiration date has not passed based upon the date that the proof of registration is presented, or queried.
