To IRP, Inc. and All IRP Member Jurisdictions - Notice of Waiver of International Registration Plan (IRP) and International Fuel Tax Agreement (IFTA) Requirements for Ontario:

Ontario has been diligently monitoring the developing situation since we first learned of COVID-19 and has acted decisively to protect the health and well-being of all Ontarians.

The Ministry of Transportation is taking steps to keep Ontarians safe and help reduce the spread of COVID-19 by extending the validation period of IRP products that have expired on or after March 1, 2020, including IRP validation tags and cab cards. This change reduces the need for in-person visits to IRP offices during the pandemic.

During this period police and enforcement officers will be directed to suspend enforcement of IRP and IFTA requirements for both Ontario and out of jurisdiction carriers. In addition, commercial motor vehicles that are legally permitted to operate in their home jurisdiction will be permitted to operate into Ontario.

We also request suspension of enforcement measures against Ontario vehicles operating in other jurisdictions in accordance to this waiver.

This waiver will remain in effect until further notice.
