Re: Further extension of registration period for motor vehicles registered in Virginia

As part of Virginia's continuing response to the COVID-19 pandemic, Governor Ralph S. Northam has again amended Executive Directive 7, originally issued on March 17, 2020, authorizing the Department of Motor Vehicles to extend the validity period of expiring vehicle registrations. Under the latest amendments to the directive, Virginia vehicle registrations that expired in March 2020 are now extended through September 30, 2020, and registrations expiring in April, May, June, and July 2020 are extended through October 31, 2020. These extensions apply to vehicles registered under the International Registration Plan.

We ask that law enforcement agencies in all IRP member jurisdictions refrain from taking action against vehicles with Virginia apportioned license plates expiring March through July 2020, until the extension periods indicated above have ended.
