**SUBJECT:** Extension of Registration Period for Motor Vehicles Registered in West Virginia

As part of West Virginia's continuing response to the COVID-19 pandemic, Commissioner Everett Frazier today directed the Division of Motor Vehicles to, among other things, extend by 90 days the validity period of Vehicle registrations due to expire on or before May 15, 2020. The extension applies to vehicles registered under the International Registration Plan.

We ask that law enforcement agencies in all IRP member jurisdictions refrain from taking action against vehicles with West Virginia apportioned license plates expiring in March and April 2020, until the 90-day extension period has ended.
