Traveling to Canada with a Commercial Vehicle?

Before entering Canada with your commercial vehicle, ensure compliance with the following requirements. Some jurisdictions may have additional conditions. For jurisdiction-specific registration and contact information, refer to the IRP (International Registration Plan)

Key Requirements:

1. Canada Border Services Agency (CBSA):

- Adhere to customs regulations for cargo and vehicle entry.
- Visit the CBSA website for detailed guidance: <u>CBSA</u>

2. Carrier Codes:

- A carrier code is a four-character unique identifier assigned by CBSA to identify a carrier.
- All carriers transporting commercial goods into Canada must have a valid carrier code under the E-Manifest – Advance Commercial Information (ACI) system.
- Apply for or verify your carrier code: <u>CBSA Carrier Code Information</u>

3. Insurance Requirements:

- Commercial vehicles must have minimum third-party liability and cargo insurance, depending on the commodity hauled.
- British Columbia is the only Canadian jurisdiction requiring insurance certificates to be filed.
- Contact the Insurance Corporation of British Columbia (ICBC) for financial responsibility filings: ICBC Prorate Plates

4. Third-Party Liability Coverage:

- General Freight: Minimum of CAD \$1,000,000.
- Dangerous Goods: Minimum of CAD \$2,000,000.

5. Cargo Insurance (For-Hire Carriers Only):

- GVW up to 12,700 kg (27,998 lbs): Minimum of CAD \$15,000.
- GVW up to 21,000 kg (46,296 lbs): Minimum of CAD \$20,000.
- GVW up to 37,000 kg (81,570 lbs): Minimum of CAD \$27,000.
- GVW over 37,000 kg (81,570 lbs): Minimum of CAD \$32,000.

6. **Public Liability Coverage for Buses:**

- Passenger Capacity 15 or less: CAD \$1,000,000.
- Passenger Capacity 16 or more: CAD \$3,000,000.



7. Vehicle Registration:

- Commercial vehicles traveling into Canada must be registered.
- Registration can be done through the International Registration Plan (IRP) or by purchasing Trip Permits in the relevant jurisdictions.
- GVW thresholds and requirements vary by jurisdiction.
