Registration Now Open for New York 2024 ISPA Congress

Bridging the Gap
January 9 – 11, 2024

New York, NY, USA (September 5, 2023) – Registration is now open for the **New York 2024 ISPA Congress, *Bridging the Gap***. Representing the ecosystem of the performing arts including, presenters, festivals, artist managers, funders, and other professionals within the field, more than 500 delegates from around the world are expected to attend in-person.

Congress Theme: *Bridging the Gap*

The performing arts have long provided an effective platform for exploring greater societal issues. However, the arts sector itself grapples with the same challenges, including inequities, regional conflict, generational shifts, climate change, and scarcity of funding and training resources.
