The Congress theme will be explored through a variety of sub-topics presented in various formats ensuring a highly interactive discussion. Popular programs promoting global exchange of the arts, including Pitch New Works and ProEx (Professional Exchange) will once again be held. The annual ISPA awards will be presented honoring some of the sector’s top leaders and innovations/initiatives. The Congress will be returning to the Gerald W. Lynch Theater (John Jay College) and the iconic Times Center.
