Bio

Lars Krogvold, M.D., PhD is a consultant in paediatric diabetology and endocrinology at the Children department, Oslo University Hospital, Norway.

He finished his PhD-degree in 2016 entitled “The pathogenesis of type 1 diabetes - lessons from pancreatic biopsies in the Diabetes Virus Detection Study (DiViD)”, which thoroughly described pancreatic biopsies from newly diagnosed type 1 diabetic adult patients. The collected material has so far led to more than 20 peer-reviewed articles, in close collaboration with researcher all over the world.

Krogvold is currently working 50% as a consultant and 50% as postdoctoral researcher at the University of Oslo, and this year launching a randomized controlled trial where children with new-onset T1D will be treated with anti-viral medications or placebo, as an attempt to better preserve endogenous insulin production. He is also associate professor in paediatrics at the Faculty of Odontology, University of Oslo.

In the context of ISPAD, he hosted the ISPAD science school in Oslo 2016, and was a member of the scientific committee of the annual ISPAD scientific sessions in Hyderabad in October 2018. At the same meeting, he was chosen as treasurer (elect), and after ending his training period, he replaced Andrea Scaramuzza as the Treasurer of ISPAD after the annual ISPAD scientific sessions in Boston October 2019.
