Bio

After her MD PhD (1986, Prof Bruining) in Rotterdam, Netherlands, Carine did her pediatric training in the Netherlands, Luxembourg and France (1993), followed in 1999 by pediatric endocrinology-diabetology. In 1988, she did a University DU in Public Health in Nancy, France and participated in the EURODIAB diabetes registry. Carine participated in the creation of the multidisciplinary team (DECCP) for the care of children and adolescents with diabetes in Luxembourg, a dynamic and international team. They have been recognized as Centre of Reference for Pediatric Diabetes (SWEET) as well as member of the ERN (European Reference Network) for rare diabetes. She is closely collaborating with the Luxemburg Center for System Biomedicine on the role of the microbiome. She represents Luxemburg in the PDCO/EMA.

Carine received several research grants from the EU, interregional and international funding structures. Research topics of the team include epidemiology, technology in diabetes care, and the pathogenesis of type 1 diabetes.

She published more than 140 publications in peer reviewed journals and several chapters in books.

Between 2012 and 2016 Carine was the Secretary General of ISPAD and in that function, she was able to meet with, and motivated by, many colleagues and patients around the globe, who were working on improving access to care and quality of care for young people with diabetes.
