ISTH presents the ISTH Esteemed Career Awards during the ISTH Congress to individuals who, in the opinion of their peers, have made significant contributions to the understanding, treatment and diagnosis, research and education in the thrombosis and haemostasis field.

Five awards will be conferred annually to individuals whose career contributions have significantly advanced the scientific community's understanding or treatment of diseases and disorders that affect haemostasis. Their accomplishments are internationally regarded as exemplary models of research, clinical practice and mentoring excellence.
