Introduction and General Information

The International Society on Thrombosis and Haemostasis (ISTH) is pleased to announce its **ISTH Education Workshop** taking place from May 31-June 2 in Querétaro, Mexico.

ISTH continues its successful series of courses offering training in biological and clinical aspects of thrombosis and hemostasis and is pleased to offer its first workshop in Mexico. ISTH has worked in full collaboration with the Mexican Society on Thrombosis and Hemostasis to craft the program.

Target Audience:

This meeting is targeted to:

- Clinicians and trainees in hemostasis, hematology, transfusion medicine, vascular medicine, or intensive care medicine,
- PhD wishing to acquire clinical and basic knowledge in the field, or
- Senior hematologists looking for an update.

Objectives:

By attending this workshop, participants will:

1. obtain an understanding of the latest developments in VTE and thrombosis management
2. learn to identify, diagnose and have knowledge of the latest treatment for patients with risk of thrombosis
3. have the opportunity to network with leading experts in the field of thrombosis and hemostasis, benefiting from the small training size (200 maximum participants)

The workshop will provide two and a half days of intense examination and discussions on the subjects of venous thromboembolism and other thrombotic disorders.
