GUIDELINES FOR CONFERENCE PAPERS AND POWERPOINTS

Powerpoint Guidelines

Presenters are responsible for submitting their PowerPoint slides to their session moderators in advance of the conference so that they will have the chance to review the slides and load them onto their computers. Presenters will have no more than 15-20 minutes each, so plan your PowerPoint accordingly.

Paper Guidelines

Full papers in English are required for paper sessions and panels at the ISTR conference. Completed papers should be **submitted to your session moderator by June 10, 2016**, to allow adequate time for moderators to read the paper.

There is no minimum or maximum length requirement. This means that all papers should include:

- A title
- List of Authors and affiliation
- Full text
- Full list of references
- Page numbers
- Clear and consistent formatting and language

(The [notes for contributors](#) to *Voluntas* can serve as a useful guide).

Please add the following text to the top of the first page of your paper:

“Paper submitted to the 12th International conference of the International Society for Third Sector Research,
Ersta Sköndal University College, Stockholm, Sweden, June 28 - July 1, 2016”

Post-Conference Publication and Working Paper Opportunities

Following the conference, authors are invited to revise their papers in the light of conference feedback with an eye to an appropriate submission to *Voluntas*, the peer reviewed official journal of ISTR. Publication decisions are the sole discretion of such journals and ISTR does not participate in the editorial decisions on such submissions. Authors can also submit their papers to be reviewed for selection for publication in the [ISTR Conference Working Papers Series](#) to be published after the conference on the ISTR website.
