Advanced Credit Program Information

Background:

The Advanced Credit Program (ACP) is a dual credit program, as defined by the Missouri Board of Higher Education. This program offers qualifying, high-caliber high school students in select schools the opportunity to earn college credits and become familiar with the college experience while still in a high school setting. College credits earned through the ACP are accepted at all of Missouri's public colleges and universities and many other institutions across the country.

Eligibility:

To enroll in Advanced Credit courses, the signature of a high school counselor or teacher is required to verify the eligibility requirements found below (all GPA's based on 4.0 scale)

Juniors and seniors with cumulative GPA's of 3.0 or above are automatically eligible for advanced credit courses.

Juniors and Seniors with cumulative GPA's between 2.5-2.99 are also eligible; however, they must provide a signed letter of recommendation from their principal and guidance counselor and provide written permission from a parent or legal guardian.

Cost:

One ACP credit hour is \$64. Typically classes are three credit hours in length with some exceptions.

Billing:

The billing cycle begins once the student is enrolled in the class. UMSL will send a mailing addressed to the student saying that she is in the Advanced Credit Program and they are excited for her to begin this journey. Every month a bill

will be sent addressed to your daughter until the balance has been paid in full. Be sure to not discard the mailing from UMSL with other college mailings she may receive.

Everything must be paid in full by October 31st. If not, the student will be dropped from the course.
