LISA BEHLMANN '77 WILL SERVE AS THE NEW CHAIRPERSON OF THE INCARNATE WORD ACADEMY BOARD OF TRUSTEES

The Sisters of Charity of the Incarnate Word of San Antonio are pleased to announce the appointment of Lisa Behlmann '77 as Chairperson of the Incarnate Word Academy Board of Trustees, effective July 1, 2019.

A native of Florissant, Missouri, Lisa earned a bachelor's degree in finance from Drake University, where she lettered all four years in volleyball and co-captained the team in her junior and senior years. Lisa earned a master's degree in business administration, with honors, from the University of Houston's Executive MBA Program, and, in 2006, completed the Executive Development Program "Leading Professional Services Firms" at Harvard Business School.

Lisa spent nearly thirty years in the high technology and professional services industries in the US and abroad. Her early career included finance and marketing roles with Shell Oil and Hewlett-Packard. She joined Compaq Computer (now HP) in the early 1990's and was based in Munich, Germany, from 1993 through 1996 leading European marketing initiatives for Compaq.

In 1996 she joined Korn/Ferry International, a premier global provider of executive search, management development, and talent management solutions. She was based in London, UK, for over ten years as a Senior Partner and led the European Advanced Technology Practice. She returned to the US with Korn/Ferry in 2006, as Managing Director of Global Accounts, participated on the Global Operating Committee and subsequently retired in 2009.

Lisa is a two time-inductee into the Incarnate Word Academy Hall of Fame, for athletics and business, has served on the Board since 2015, and currently serves on the Executive Committee, the Presidential Search Committee and the Advancement Committee.

Upon acceptance of her new role as Board Chairperson, Lisa commented, "I am truly honored to serve as the next Chair of the IWA Board of Trustees, and I hope to continue the high Board leadership standards set by Karen Luebbert over her years as Chair, for which we are all grateful." She continued, "I am committed to doing my best to serve the interests of our students, faculty, staff and the community."
