In light of Kansas Supreme Court Administrative Order 2020-PR-16 issued on 3/18/20, the following restricted court operations are effective immediately for family law cases in the Tenth Judicial District, Johnson County, Kansas:

- Only Protection from Abuse and Stalking case hearings will continue to be conducted in person at the Johnson County Courthouse. Only the parties and their attorneys will be permitted to be in the courtrooms. Witnesses will enter the courtroom when testifying. Other persons will not be permitted inside courtrooms.
- Hearings that require expeditious handling will be conducted via telephonic hearing or by videoconferencing. Do not assume your currently scheduled hearing is cancelled. Your assigned court will contact you with further instructions.
- Hearings that do not require expeditious handling will be continued until further order of the court. Do not assume your currently scheduled hearing is cancelled. Your assigned court will contact you with further instructions.
- Please contact your assigned court with any questions. Due to the current circumstances, email contact with your assigned court's administrative assistant is preferred. You do not need to contact the court to confirm current settings. You will be contacted if a currently scheduled setting is changed.
