KANSAS CITY, KANSAS- Please be advised that due to Kansas Supreme Court Administrative Order 2020-PR-016 and subsequent orders from Wyandotte County District Court Chief Judge Robert Burns, the Wyandotte County District Attorney's Office is closed to the public until further notice. However, the Wyandotte County District Attorney's Office remains open for emergency operations, and continues to be staffed by essential personnel.

1. All Jury Trials presently set to begin now through 4/19/2020 have been postponed. Individuals who received subpoenas to testify for a Jury Trial during that time will be notified when a new trial date is confirmed.
2. All other non-emergency court hearings have been postponed for a presently unknown period of time. Individuals who received subpoenas to testify in a non-Jury Trial setting are encouraged to contact the office by phone during normal business hours within 48 hours of the hearing date for updated information.
3. Victim/Witness Advocates and Attorneys will still be available to speak with victims, witnesses, and other concerned parties regarding the status of upcoming cases during this time. Individuals are encouraged to contact the office by phone during normal business hours with questions or concerns regarding a case.
4. Police and evidentiary reports will continue to be processed as they are received, and will be made available to attorneys as soon as practical once the office re-opens to the public.

The Wyandotte County District Attorney's Office wants first to thank all first responders; including police, fire, EMS, dispatchers, and medical personnel for their dedication to our health and safety on the front lines of this pandemic. We will continue to pray for them as they fight for us. We also want to thank the public for continued patience and understanding during this uncertain time. My staff and I remain dedicated to serving the community as best we can during this closure.
