Session 1 – Utilities 101: Introduction to Utilities Management

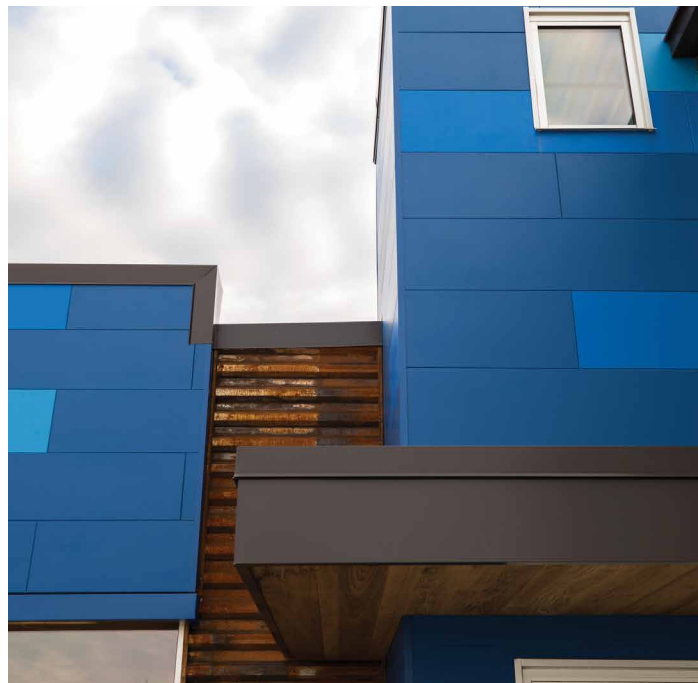
