2019 Water & Wastewater Workshops

EMERGENCY PREPAREDNESS

5 hours of water or wastewater operator credit available

Emergency Preparedness workshops focus on water and wastewater utility resiliency in the event of an emergency. Each day-long workshop will be available for 5 hours of water or wastewater operator credit, and will include hands-on table top exercises. There is no charge to attend, but you will need to register.

SURFACE WATER TREATMENT

5 hours of water operator credit available

Source water considerations and surface water treatment processes will be discussed in this workshop, along with important compliance rules and regulations. An overview of the Surface Water Treatment Rule will be given, including compliance, CT calculations, sample site plans and sample collections.

The discussion of Stage 2 DBP Rule will also focus on compliance, purchase systems, water age management, infrastructure considerations and O&M maintenance.

This workshop will include a hands-on lab sampling component, starting with process, procedures, and closing with hands-on sample collection.

EXAM PREP – CLASS II, III, IV

5 hours of water operator credit available

This workshop will consist of advanced water operations topics to aid Class II, III and IV operators in successful exam preparation. This training will utilize AWWA Water Systems Operations (WSO) resources. The WSO series is the only widely used certification training material that conforms to the latest Association of Boards of Certification (ABC) Need-to-Know criteria (similar to KDHE Operators Need-To-Know). For certification training to meet the highest standards and be applicable to the widest audience, it is crucial that materials be developed in accordance with the latest Operator Need-To-Know criteria.

DISTRIBUTION SYSTEM RULES

5 hours of water or wastewater operator credit available

This training will include LCR & RTRC overviews, updates, and compliance, including: site sample plans, sample locations, material evaluations, and certification of deliveries. CT positives will be discussed, understanding real detects versus sampling issues. There is also a hands-on sampling lab component to this workshop, giving attendees an understanding of proper procedures and technique demonstrations, followed by actual attendee sample collection. Other areas of instruction will include Data Collector, Level 1 Assessments, repeat samples, and the Groundwater Rule.

Funding for this training is provided through a contractual agreement between the Kansas Department of Health & Environment, PWS Capacity Development Program, State Revolving Fund Set-aside and Kansas Municipal Utilities.
