INSTRUCTIONS

All applications must be typed, and each section completed fully (incomplete submissions will not be considered/evaluated). Forms must be signed by both the applicant and the employer/sponsor and received by the Leadership PE Selection Committee no later than **June 30, 2025**. All submissions must contain two recent photos suitable for use in publications and for publicity purposes.

SELECTION CRITERIA

Participation in Leadership PE is a competitive process open to persons living or working in Kentucky. Applicants must be a member of Kentucky Society of Professional Engineers (NSPE-KY), the American Council of Engineering Companies of Kentucky (ACEC-KY), or the Kentuckiana Post of the Society of Military Engineers (KP-SAME). Typically, fifteen individuals will be selected to participate in the program each year. Participants must be either a PE or an EIT.

Participants will be chosen by the Leadership PE Selection Committee based upon the information provided in this application. The Committee will seek representation from a cross-section of the state. These leaders and potential leaders will be active in business, education, the arts, religion, government, community-based organizations, and/or ethnic and minority groups with the goal of reflecting the diversity of the state and the profession.

Applicants must have been living or working in Kentucky for one year prior to submitting the application and have the full support of their employer.
