Lawyers Club Endorses Matt Brower for San Diego Court Judge

Lawyers Club of San Diego endorses Matt Brower in the November 6, 2018 general election for a contested San Diego County Superior Court seat. The Lawyers Club Board of Directors has voted to endorse **Matthew R. Brower**, who is seeking election for Seat No. 34.

Matt Brower is vying for the seat held by Superior Court Judge Gary Kreep, who was given a public censure last year by the state Commission on Judicial Performance for “engag[ing] in a pattern of misconduct that demonstrates a lack of judicial temperament.”

Any judicial candidate may seek Lawyers Club’s support or endorsement, and Lawyers Club’s Judicial Elections Endorsement Committee evaluates each candidate who seeks endorsement and makes recommendations to the board, which makes the final decision.

Brower has worked as a Deputy District Attorney for the San Diego County District Attorney’s office since 2012. In that capacity, he serves as a team leader of the Regional Auto Theft Task Force (RATT), an inter-agency task force. Brower also serves in the Marine Corps Reserve as a judge advocate – a Marine officer who practices law. He frequently serves in the role of Preliminary Hearing Officer presiding over in-court criminal preliminary hearings in cases including murders, sex crimes and complex thefts. Prior to joining the DA’s Office, Brower served in the Marine Corps Judge Advocate Division. While on deployments with Marine infantry battalions in Iraq and Afghanistan, Brower garnered significant operational and international legal experience. Brower is currently assigned to European Command in Stuttgart, Germany, where he practices fiscal and international law.
