



Ellen Olsen, LCSW, MBA is currently the Executive Director of the Pre-admission Screening and Resident Review (PASRR) Program, KEPRO Florida. Ellen has worked in the behavioral health field for over twenty years and the PASRR field for ten of those years. She serves as Vice Chair of the Board of Directors for the National Association of PASRR Professionals (NAPP) as well as Chair of the Technology Committee. She has been a Licensed Clinical Social Worker in the state of Florida since 2003 and also holds a Master's degree in Business Administration from Florida State University.

Current activities include operational and financial oversight of KEPRO Florida contracts, including the new PASRR contract with the Agency for Health Care Administration (AHCA), and close collaboration with the Substance Abuse and Mental Health, Department of Children and Families (DCF) and the Agency for Persons with Disabilities (APD) for PASRR program oversight. Our programs work very closely with Florida's state agencies to ensure an efficient, effective and collaborative PASRR process.
