Application Must Include:

- **Application Form**
- **Two Essays** - in response to: "What are your leadership goals for aging services?" and "What is your commitment to the field of aging services?" Each essay should be one page, double-spaced.
- **Two Letters of Reference** - These letters should speak to the applicant's leadership performance, potential and commitment to non-profit aging services.
- **Current Resumé** - The resumé must include complete documentation of education and relevant work experience.
- **Commitment Form** - Completed by both the applicant and sponsoring organization.

Applications will be evaluated by an experienced and diverse committee based on the following criteria:

- How well-defined, insightful, and introspective the leadership essays are;
- Does the applicant demonstrate a personal commitment to aging services
- Does the applicant demonstrate a dedication to lifelong learning; and
- To what extent does the applicant possess the leadership capacity needed to become a transformational leader.
