LeadingAge Florida Applauds Governor for Enacting Continuing Care Provider Legislation

TALLAHASSEE— LeadingAge Florida, Florida's only association representing the entire continuum of care for older adults, offered its appreciation today to Governor DeSantis for signing the Continuing Care Retirement Community (CCRC) Legislation (CS/CS/HB 1573) into law. The new law will help ensure the future viability and financial strength of the CCRC model in Florida.

The legislation, championed by LeadingAge Florida, its members, and the Florida Life Care Resident's Association, includes reforms that will benefit both senior living communities and the residents they serve.
