The goals of the LTC & Dementia ECHO are to better support nursing homes and assisted living communities as they manage dementia, and to improve the care of residents and their families.

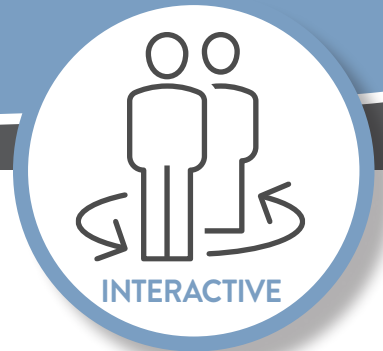
What's Involved?

Healthcare Teams participate in tele-ECHO sessions to develop enhanced skills and best practices in an “all teach all learn” virtual environment over an 8-week period.

Each 1-hour session includes a 15 minute topic presented by content specialists as well as case studies presented by participating nursing and assisted living communities.
