Summary Results

October 2005

Overview

- Over 1,005 responses were received from 3,348 members surveyed, a 30% response rate.
- More than **60%** of participants are employed by industrial corporations. Responses were closely representative of industry sectors in the survey population.
- The most prevalent job titles were Director (29%) and Manager (25%).

Overall Results

• Median Base Salary \$127,500

• Median Bonus 7.5% (35% reported none)


• Median Total 2005 Cash Compensation \$157,500

- This year, **48%** of respondents will receive **stock options**. Stock options were most prevalent in the Northeast and with Telecommunications, Electronics and Biotechnology firms.
- 29% of respondents have 5-10 years of experience.
- 60% of participants have been LES members for 3 years or more.
- 87% of respondents have a Post-Graduate Degree.




LES 2005 Compensation Survey Base Salary




LES 2005 Compensation Survey Median Base Salary by Industry Sector




LES 2005 Compensation Survey Median Base Salary by Region
