### OVERVIEW

On October 1, 2015, the U.S. healthcare system transitioned the way patient visits are coded from ICD-9 to the next version ICD-10, a system that sets the stage for meaningful improvements in public health. If people know about ICD-10 at all, it's probably from press reports about the more colorful diagnostic codes like "other contact with shark" or "burn due to water-skis on fire, subsequent encounter." More seriously, for people in the healthcare industry, it was being compared to Y2K, a transition with the potential to create chaos in the healthcare system. For thousands of hospital, physicians and other clinicians around the country, the change to ICD-10 was a big undertaking, requiring time, planning, and a period of adjustment. On Oct 1, proper execution and good implementation made all the difference. Attend this webinar to learn about success stories as well as what still challenges in the industry we can expect.
