**OVERVIEW:**

This program will provide content geared towards the Infection Preventionist (IP) who has worked in the field for more than two years. Content will include topics identified as priority by attendees of the Fall 2018 Infection Prevention Bootcamp including management of patients requiring isolation, execution of an effective hand hygiene program, and the role of the IP in construction renovation. Cross-cutting topics such as engagement, influence and change management will be included. This workshop will be highly interactive and engaging. It is designed to be informative, enhance more advanced knowledge and creative approaches to infection prevention.
