OVERVIEW:

Every year, hundreds of changes are made to CPT, HCPCS and ICD-10. Additional changes to coverage and documentation requirements are issued by CMS. There are substantial changes in 2019 to E/M, dermatology, lab and other specialties. The adequacy of clinical documentation and accuracy of coding are critical to an organization's compliance, and financial success. It is crucial to ensure that your staff knows and understand the changes and that the updates are made to your systems in a correct and timely manner is crucial.
