OVERVIEW:

Even though the number of changes to the Joint Commission Hospital Standards are few in 2020, some topics continue to be problematic related to suicide screening, environmental and infection control risk assessments, sterile processing and sterile compounding. These identified topics are still challenging for hospitals to attain and maintain compliance on a consistent basis. Because of organizational staff turnover, it is important for hospitals to revisit preparation strategies that can assist staff members who are new to their positions, as well as reinforce items to seasoned staff. By attending this year's virtual Hospital Accreditation Standards Update, hospital staff will learn how better to promote participant networking and provide information needed to understand and heighten awareness of new standards. continued problematic standards and requirements for improvement that are being scored during Joint Commission Surveys.
