This webinar will focus on recent changes, areas of focus, and trouble spots regarding the Joint Commission Life Safety Standards that are based on the NFPA 101 Life Safety Code - 2012 Edition. The presentation is also applicable to hospitals that are accredited by DNV Healthcare that also enforces the Life Safety Code - 2012 Edition. The program will review requirements regarding Interim Life Safety Measures, Life Safety Drawings, and areas of focus regarding the Life Safety Code Healthcare Occupancy requirements.

- Understand current requirements regarding Statement of Conditions and Life Safety Code assessment;
- Understand when interim life safety measures are required;
- Understand requirements for life safety drawings;

- Understand when a risk assessment of an operating room as a wet procedure location is required.
