It is with great pleasure that we welcome Dr. Patricia Beckmann to WINGS. She will serve as vice-president of Commercialization at Life Science Washington and through that position as Managing Director of WINGS. We know you will agree that Patricia's varied background is a great fit with our WINGS community.



Patricia's career spans biomedical research, operations, law and venture capital. She spent most of her research career at Immunex (coinventor of Enbrel®, Mobista® and Nuvance®) as well as several years in the Immunex and Amgen Law Departments performing technology assessment for licensing, intellectual property and litigation support. She was part of the bioscience investment team at Vulcan Capital and the original strategy team establishing the Allen Institute for Brain Sciences. She was founding Chief Scientific Officer at the Acceleratorbacked diagnostics company Homestead (now Integrated Diagnostics) and a Kauffman Fellow at Accelerator. Subsequently she was President and Executive Director of the non-profit Oregon Translational Research and Development Institute (OTRADI) where she established a small fund and incubator model for Oregon start-ups. More recently Patricia has been Managing Director of BioStrategy, LLC where she has advised early-stage biotechnology, medical device, digital health agriculturally-related companies.

She earned her undergraduate degree at the Evergreen State College in biology, chemistry and art and her PhD in biochemistry and pharmacology from the University of Arizona, College of Medicine. Patricia is a two-time Fulbright Fellowship recipient (Sweden and India). She pursued postdoctoral studies as an American Cancer Society Fellow at the Ludwig Institute for Cancer Research in Uppsala, Sweden and as an NRSA Fellow at the National Cancer Institute. She has over 50 peerreviewed scientific publications and more than 40 issued U.S. Patents.

On a more personal note, Patricia raises golden retrievers, loves music, cooking and great red wines. 

Roll the Tape: A look back at 2014 Q4 WINGS companies

- I spoke with Andrew of **Circle Technologies**. While they have interest in their technology they have not been able to attract investment on acceptable terms. They are going to take a step back and pursue additional grants to further develop the technology, then hire a CEO and re-enter the funding market. They could use some additional seed money to help them in the grant process.
- <u>Transverse Medical</u> is also tracking well with their screening tool to protect the brain during heart surgeries. They used their \$3 million seed round to complete their preclinical study and are now raising a \$10 million A round.
- Many of you will recall <u>Cyrus Biotechnology</u>, where Wings members have invested over \$300k of the \$1.8 million raised. They are getting great traction with customers of their SaaS protein design tools. They have over \$500k in contractual revenue for 2016, with customers including:

6 of top-20 Global Pharma

9 paid beta SaaS customers

13 design/SaaS combo contracts – 6 in Fortune 500

They will be raising their A round soon. Lucas Nivón and the team have been very appreciative of the WINGS support!

- Have IP protection and/or barrier to entry
- Be prepared to begin due diligence after the WINGS investor meeting
