LEGISLATIVE UPDATE

INTERNET SALES TAX: The legislature failed to override Governor Kelly's veto of *HB 2033*, the Mega Tax Bill, the bill contained a number of provisions including requiring the out-of-state vendors to collect and remit sales tax. We will continue to work on this issue between now and next session. The Legislature officially adjourned this week.

Last day to register to vote for the Primary Election

First day advance voting ballots are mailed and in-person advance voting may begin

August 6
PRIMARY ELECTION
(If needed, Primary election are only held of one more than three times the number of candidates per position file for office.)

October 15
Last day to register to vote for the General Election

October 16
First day advance voting ballots are mailed and first day of in-person advance voting

November 5

NLC FISCAL CONDITIONS SURVEY

The National League of Cities is currently conducting its annual City Fiscal Conditions survey to better understand local fiscal and economic trends. **NLC has offered to provide state-level fiscal conditions analyses for states that generate a response rate of at least 30%.**

Our state needs participation from **188 cities** (at least 18 cities with a population of 10,000 or more) to obtain the necessary response rate.
