



Use Two-Factor Authentication

Having a unique, unguessable password for every account is one piece of the puzzle. But if you use two-factor authentication, recent surveys by Google and Microsoft found that you can reduce the likelihood of an account breach by 99%.

Two-Factor Authentication

Two-factor authentication is based on a principle of three. To up your security, you want to secure your account with at least two of three factors.

Something You Know

A password, security question or another knowledge-based credential.



Something You Have

A phone where you receive a code or a separate email sent to another device.



Something You Are

Biometrics such as your fingerprint, face recognition, iris or other personal bio identifier.




Not All Two-Factor Authentications Are Created Equal

Many banks and shopping sites require two-factor authentication, making you stop to get a code on your phone or via email to verify your identity.

But scammers can manipulate SMS-based verifications, tricking you into giving up your code or rerouting the codes to their devices. Instead you can use a third-party authenticator app or a security device to serve as a verifier.

After you set up two-factor authentication with an account, authenticator apps will generate six-digit, one-time passcodes that refresh every 30 seconds. You enter the one-time-use code into your account to login.




